



## **KS1 & KS2 Knowledge and Understanding of Places**

### GEOGRAPHY

The layout of Hutton le Hole is typical of a medieval village with the beck running through the centre and a street on either side. This village could be used as a contrasting locality with the one in which your school is set. The Museum, with its amazing collection of rescued and furnished houses, from the medieval to the Victorian period, enables children to understand the historical development of village life and together with the craft shops, gives a perfect picture of the interdependence of village, farm and traditional crafts.

Two particularly relevant activities to aid understanding are 'cruck frame building' (see Tudors) and the 'school' (see Victorians).
